#	NAME	DESCRIPTION
1	The Patty Ahearn-Victoria Elementary School	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior from any Redlands Unified high school who has a 2.5 GPA or higher. This student must have attended Victoria Elementary School for at least three years and has continued to follow the Victoria Peace Builder's Pledge.
2	American Business Women's Association	A \$500 or greater scholarship will be awarded to a graduating female senior seeking a business or professional career. Selection is based on scholastic standing and financial need.
3	Cesar E. Chavez Memorial	This \$750 scholarship celebrates Cesar E. Chavez's legacy of compassion, education and equality for all Americans. It will awarded to a graduating senior who has shown exemplary leadership, given community service, and shows financial need. Please write a short essay explaining how you exemplify his spirit and how you intend to further honor it. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: CESAR E. CHAVEZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
4	Rachel Graham Memorial	Several scholarships at \$500 each will be awarded to graduating seniors who will attend a four-year college or university on a full-time basis. They must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA, shown good citizenship and participated in school and community activities.
5	Grove School PTG	These \$500 scholarships will be awarded to outstanding students who have fully embraced the Montessori educational philosophy. Applicants should submit a 500 word essay following the prompt: How will you apply the lessons of your Montessori education to your college experience. The selection committee will be looking for specific examples from your high school experience that demonstrate your achievements in areas such as citizenship, community service, interdisciplinary or growth as an independent learner. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: GROVE PTA
6	Owen Locke Memorial	These scholarships are available to students with a 3.0 GPA or above and who demonstrate financial need. Please note you may not have applied for other Owen Locke scholarships offered by an organization other than the RCSF.
7	Optimist Club of Redlands Foundation	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student who has a positive attitude and has been involvement in service to the community.

8	The PoWeR To Continue Learning	This \$500 scholarship, offered by the Professional Women of Redlands, will be awarded to a graduating young woman who possesses a minimum 2.5 GPA, has participated in at least one school activity, and has demonstrated some type of community service. The recipient must be planning to attend a two-year or four-year college, or a vocational program. Preference will be given to a student who will be the first in her family to obtain a college degree or professional-level training. A short essay must be attached on the topic, Why I Want to Continue My Education. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: THE POWER TO CONTINUE LEARNING.
9	Redlands Kiwanis Club Foundation	Several \$5,000 scholarships will be paid over a 4-year period to students with the following qualifications: A high GPA upon graduation from high school, good citizenship, and extracurricular activity involvement with demonstrated leadership ability. The recipients will be selected through an interviewing process conducted by the Redlands Noon Kiwanis Club scholarship committee.
10	Redlands Rotary Club Foundation	One scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated high academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and service to school and community. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
11	Redlands Sunrise Rotary Club	This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a minimum 3.0 GPA or better, has been active in school and community, and has demonstrated outstanding citizenship. The recipient must plan to be enrolled in college.
