#	NAME	DESCRIPTION
1	The AEI-CASC Engineering Scholarship	Three \$500 scholarships will be awarded to outstanding graduating seniors who intend to pursue a degree in Engineering at a four-year college or university. Students pursuing any Engineering degree are eligible, preference will be given to qualified students entering a program in Civil or Environmental Engineering. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, demonstrate an interest in an Engineering career and be involved in community service and/or extracurricular activities.
2	The Patty Ahearn-Victoria Elementary School	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior from any Redlands Unified high school who has a 2.5 GPA or higher. This student must have attended Victoria Elementary School for at least three years and has continued to follow the Victoria Peace Builder's Pledge.
3	American Business Women's Association	A \$500 or greater scholarship will be awarded to a graduating female senior seeking a business or professional career. Selection is based on scholastic standing and financial need.
4	American Legion Post #650 - Philip Marmolejo	A \$500 or greater scholarship will be awarded to a student with a B or higher GPA. The student must be a son, daughter, grandchild, great-grandchild, sister or brother of a Veteran. The student must provide the name of said Veteran and the branch of military service he or she was enlisted in. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: AMERICAN LEGION POST #650 SCHOLARSHIP.
5	Frank G. Araujo Memorial	Four scholarships of \$500 will be awarded to students of Mexican-American descent. The recipients must have a 3.0 or higher GPA, demonstrate good citizenship, and participate in school or community activities.
6	Connie "Chelo" Armendariz Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior planning to continue his/her education at a vocational school, junior college, or university. Preference shall be given to a student who attended the former Saint Mary's Catholic Church in Redlands. Applicants must indicate the years they attended this church. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: CONNIE ARMENDARIZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.
7	Arroyo Verde Elementary School PTA	Two \$500 scholarships may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Arroyo Verde Elementary School. The recipient must have a minimum 3.25 GPA if attending a four-year college or a minimum 2.5 GPA if attending a community college or vocational-technical school. The recipient must have also demonstrated good character and citizenship during his or her high school career.

8	Zackary Bearden Memorial	This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is planning a career in the film industry. The student must be enrolled in video production or REV Week. He/she must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher and submit a two (2) minute video on a DVD or CD and hand it in with the completed application.
9	Beattie Middle School PTA	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who attended Beattie Middle School, has a 2.5 GPA or higher, and demonstrates good citizenship. Consideration will also be based on the student/family participation in PTA/PTSA membership and activities.
10	Beaver Medical Clinic Foundation - Premedical Award	One \$4,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is seeking a career in the field of medicine. The student must be outstanding both academically and in leadership skills, ensuring success in his or her planned career.
11	Raymond and Donald Beeler Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student with at least a 3.0 GPA. Financial need is a consideration. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who will attend a community or a four-year college on a full-time basis.
12	Benchwarmers Club of Redlands - Bill Slinkard Football	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a three-year member of the Redlands East Valley football team who has been a starter for at least one year, exhibited good citizenship, dedication, and has an eligible GPA.
13	Barbara Bonnema Memorial	Several \$500 or greater scholarships may be awarded to students who show academic excellence as well as a financial need. The students must also be college-bound graduating seniors who will be attending school on a full-time basis.
14	Boy Scouts of America Troop 3 Art Till/Nathan E. Smith Memorial	Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plan to attend an accredited college, university, or vocational program. Continued involvement in scouting and community service will be considered. Preference will be given to individuals who have attained the rank of Eagle Scout.
15	Quincy Brown Memorial	A scholarship of \$500 or greater will be awarded to a graduating senior who will enroll as a full-time student in a four-year college or university pursuing a business or teaching career. The student must have a 3.0 or higher GPA and have attended a Redlands Unified School District school for three consecutive years.
16	Kelly Bullwinkle Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who has a 2.5 GPA or above. He or she must have an interest in creative writing as well as a love for horses and English riding. The student should also have an interest in cross-country, track and music. A short essay must be attached on the topic: Someone who has changed my life. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: KELLY BULLWINKLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.

17	Kathy Bush Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has been outstanding in the field of instrumental music.
18	Brianna Cadman Memorial	A \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has or is currently dealing with a hardship in his or her life. Submit a writing showing How this hardship has affected me and my family and what I did or could do to make it better. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: BRIANNA CADMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.
19	Cesar E. Chavez Memorial	This \$750 scholarship celebrates Cesar E. Chavez's legacy of compassion, education and equality for all Americans. It will awarded to a graduating senior who has shown exemplary leadership, given community service, and shows financial need. Please write a short essay explaining how you exemplify his spirit and how you intend to further honor it. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: CESAR E. CHAVEZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
20	Clement Middle School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended and was involved in school activities at Clement Middle School.
21	J. and M. Cole	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated good citizenship and is active in a local group such as a church or a community service organization. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and be attending college full-time. Students of an employed single parent and with financial need are given first consideration.
22	Contemporary Club	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who will continue to further his or her education in a career of his or her choice.
23	Crafton Elementary School PTA	A \$500 scholarship will be given to a graduating senior from REV, RHS or CVHS who has a financial need and has demonstrated outstanding community service through his or her high school years. The student must have attended Crafton Elementary School.
24	Cram Elementary School PTA	These \$300 scholarships may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Cram Elementary School for at least two years and has a 3.0 GPA or better. One scholarship is for a student going to a four-year college and another scholarship is for a student going to a two-year college.
25	Arthur H. Daniels Memorial	A scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating senior for citizenship, academic accomplishment, contribution to school and community, and future career plans. This scholarship will be granted to a college-bound student who plans to attend on a full-time basis.
26	Mike DeHoog Memorial	This \$500 scholarship is awarded in memory of Mike DeHoog, whose passions included architecture, photography, and woodworking. Preference will be given to a student with similar interests and plans to attend a vocational or technical school after graduation.

27	Franklin Elementary School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Franklin Elementary School and has extensive volunteer service in both school and community. Academic standing and financial need will be taken into consideration.
28	Gail Garner Memorial R.I.S.E.	A scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a student graduating through the Redlands Independent Study Education (R.I.S.E.) program from RHS, REV, CVHS, or OHS.
29	Bill Gibson Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a 3.0 GPA or higher and plans to attend a college, university, or vocational school on a full-time basis.
30	Ann and Brad Glassco	This \$500 scholarship is to be awarded to a student who has spent significant time during his/her high school years perfecting unusual skills that are outside of his/her high school interests. He/she must have been recognized for their accomplishments (i.e. Brandenberger Award at the Great Y Circus, state championship rider, Junior Olympic diver, professional performer.) The student must have a 2.5 GPA or better.
31	Rachel Graham Memorial	Several scholarships at \$500 each will be awarded to graduating seniors who will attend a four-year college or university on a full-time basis. They must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA, shown good citizenship and participated in school and community activities.
32	Junior Women of the Contemporary Club	This \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated outstanding community service in countless areas during his/her high school years.
33	Annette and Ernest Keith Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is in the top ten percent (10%) of his or her class and will be attending a four-year California college or university on a full-time basis.
34	Kimberly Elementary School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Kimberly Elementary School for a minimum of three years, is an average or above-average achiever, demonstrates good citizenship, and preferably has not received other scholarships.
35	Kingsbury Elementary School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Kingsbury Elementary School for at least three years, has a minimum of a C average, and has demonstrated good citizenship and leadership. The student must show financial need. Involvement in extracurricular and community activities must be demonstrated.
36	Krause Family	Ward and Barbara Krause are Redlands educators who enjoy travel and believe that speaking other languages is an important skill in today's world. This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a college-bound student with a minimum 3.0 GPA who is bi-lingual or has excelled in foreign language at REV. Please attach a brief paragraph explaining why you are qualified for this scholarship. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: KRAUSE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP.

37	Amy Leeming Challenge Awards	Six \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who have overcome a significant challenge, obstacle, hardship or physical, emotional, or learning disability, and who now hope to continue their education in some manner. A short essay must be attached on the topic: What challenges I have overcome. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: AMY LEEMING CHALLENGE AWARDS.
38	Doreen Legg Memorial	This scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating senior who will enroll full-time at a four-year college or university pursuing a business or teaching career. The recipient must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and attended a RUSD High School for three consecutive years.
39	Jack A. and Louise S. Levine Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who plans to continue his or her education, has a 3.0 or higher GPA, demonstrates good citizenship, and has participated in school and/or community activities.
40	Lugonia Alumni/Harrison Lightfoot	Several \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who attended Lugonia Elementary School. The students must have extensive community service and/or be involved in school activities, demonstrate good citizenship, and have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. The scholarship may be used at any college, university, or vocational school.
41	Owen Locke Memorial	These scholarships are available to students with a 3.0 GPA or above and who demonstrate financial need. Please note you may not have applied for other Owen Locke scholarships offered by an organization other than the RCSF.
42	Mariposa Elementary School PTA	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Mariposa Elementary School for at least two years. The recipient must have demonstrated serious scholarship, good citizenship, and a desire for further education either in academics or a vocational trade.
43	Maximum Turbine Support	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student with a 2.5 GPA or higher and is planning on attending a trade school or 2-year college with an interest in a career as a mechanic, welder, plumber, electrician, fireman or nurse.
44	M.E.C.C.A. - Jo Bohlman Community Service	The Mentone Educational Community Club may award a \$300 scholarship to a graduating senior who attended Mentone Elementary School for at least three years and Redlands East Valley High School for at least one year, and who preferably lives within the Mentone Elementary School boundaries at the time of graduation.
45	Moore Middle School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Moore Middle School for three years and plans to attend college or a trade school.

46	Harry Munoz Memorial	This \$1000 scholarship is presented in memory of Harry Munoz, a Redlands High School graduate of the class of 1940. Mr. Munoz lettered in four major sports and was a lifetime resident of Redlands and an active member of the community. This scholarship is given to a deserving graduate who has demonstrated academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and a desire to continue his/her education.
47	Rick Munoz Memorial	This \$500 scholarship is presented in memory of Rick Munoz. The recipient must have lettered in at least one sport in his or her senior year, as well as demonstrated high academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and a desire to continue his or her education.
48	Northside Booster Club - Felix R. Sepulveda Memorial	The Northside Booster Club has established these \$500 scholarships to encourage athletes to maintain a good academic average. The scholarships will be awarded to a graduating male and female who have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA and participated in at least one sport.
49	Optimist Club of Redlands - Swen Larson	A \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior girl who has a minimum 3.0 GPA, a positive attitude and involvement in service to the community.
50	Optimist Club of Redlands - Mike McGary	A \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior boy who has a minimum 3.0 GPA, a positive attitude and involvement in service to the community.
51	PCH Architects LLP - Steven J. Lehnhof Memorial Architectural	A \$500 scholarship is presented in memory of Steven J. Lehnhof, an architecture and drafting teacher at Redlands High School for many years. It will be awarded to a graduating senior who will be majoring in architecture or architectural engineering at an accredited college or university.
52	James Halsey Pearce Memorial Scholarship	This \$300 scholarship is offered to a special education student continuing on to college. The recipient must have special needs in high school. A short statement explaining the special circumstances of the recipient must be attached. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: JAMES HALSEY PEARCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.
53	The PoWeR To Continue Learning	This \$500 scholarship, offered by the Professional Women of Redlands, will be awarded to a graduating young woman who possesses a minimum 2.5 GPA, has participated in at least one school activity, and has demonstrated some type of community service. The recipient must be planning to attend a two-year or four-year college, or a vocational program. Preference will be given to a student who will be the first in her family to obtain a college degree or professional-level training. A short essay must be attached on the topic, Why I Want to Continue My Education. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: THE POWER TO CONTINUE LEARNING.

54	Alice Raumin Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating young woman with a minimum 3.0 GPA who is planning to enter a medical field. Students entering any medical profession are eligible; however, preference will be given to qualified students entering a program leading to a degree in registered nursing.
55	Redlands Administrative Personnel Association	Scholarships of \$500 or more will be awarded to the sons and daughters of members of RAPA. A screening committee composed of RAPA members will meet to determine the most deserving applicant, based on an objective scoring system.
56	Redlands Area Interfaith Council	This \$300 scholarship was created from the long history of promoting love and respect among all of the people of faith in our community. The student must provide a one-page essay using the following prompt: How I Can Be an Agent of Peace. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: REDLANDS AREA INTERFAITH COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP.
57	Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth	This \$350 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has participated in the Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth program, including scorekeepers or umpires, for a minimum of three years. The student must have exemplified good sportsmanship and academic achievement. Please include a 200 word essay entitled How Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth Has Impacted My Life. Indicate how many years and in what capacity you participated, i.e.: Player, Umpire, Scorekeeper. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: REDLANDS BASEBALL - SOFTBALL FOR YOUTH.
58	Redlands Community Hospital Auxiliary	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who will attend a college or university and major in some type of allied-health program. The recipient must be a Redlands Community Hospital junior volunteer and must complete 100 hours of volunteer service by the end of the school year.
59	Redlands Council PTA - Dorothy Jolley Memorial	This \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a minimum 3.0 GPA and is active in a non-school service group such as church, scouts, or a community service club.
60	Redlands Community Scholarship Foundation - Honoring Ed Gleitsman	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior to assist in his or her pursuit of higher education in a business field.
61	Redlands Community Scholarship Foundation	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior to assist in his or her pursuit of higher education.

62	Redlands Education Support Professionals Association	A \$1000 or greater scholarship will be awarded to the most deserving student within the Redlands Unified School District. The student must have a 2.5 or higher GPA, be the son or daughter of a RESPA member, and wish to attend an institution of higher learning. The student must present an essay in 100 words or less using the following prompt: What Education Means to Me. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: REDLANDS EDUCATIONAL SUPORT PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP.
63	Redlands Evening Lions Club - Barbara Westen Memorial	This \$350 scholarship will be awarded to help a deserving graduate pursue his or her training beyond high school. First preference is given to a student with a hearing or sight disability, in which case the amount will double to \$700. If no recipient meets these criteria, the recipient must have scholastic ability. Financial need is also considered. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: REDLANDS EVENING LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP.
64	Redlands East Valley PTSA	Several \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors applying to a two or four year institution or vocational school. PTSA membership, a minimum 2.5 GPA, school/community involvement, and being a graduate in good standing are considerations.
65	Redlands Kiwanis Club Foundation	Several \$5,000 scholarships will be paid over a 4-year period to students with the following qualifications: A high GPA upon graduation from high school, good citizenship, and extracurricular activity involvement with demonstrated leadership ability. The recipients will be selected through an interviewing process conducted by the Redlands Noon Kiwanis Club scholarship committee.
66	Redlands Kiwanis Club Run Thru Redlands Career Technical Scholarship	This \$1250 scholarship is awarded to support Career Technical students at the post-secondary level in order to promote a skilled technical workforce. The criteria are a 2.5 GPA or better, a demonstrated interest and aptitude in a technical area, enrollment in a program of study for less than a bachelor's degree, and involvement in community service and/or extracurricular activities.
67	Redlands Morning Kiwanis Club Foundation: Honoring Larry B. Moore	Three \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors with financial aid. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (senior year), performed community service, and was a member of Kiwanis Key Club (preferred).
68	Redlands Rotary Club - Donald C. Anderson	One scholarship of \$2,500 will be awarded to a graduating senior who has shown the highest academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and service to school and community. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.

69	Redlands Rotary Club - Ernest L. Cronemeyer	A \$4,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has shown the highest in academic achievements, outstanding citizenship, and service to school and community. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
70	Redlands Rotary Club - Edgar Fisher Memorial	This scholarship of \$3,000 will be presented to an active member of the Interact Club. High academic achievement and good citizenship are taken into consideration. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
71	Redlands Rotary Club Foundation	One scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated high academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and service to school and community. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
72	Redlands Rotary Club Foundation Discretionary	Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to an outstanding student who intends to pursue higher education at a two-year or four-year college.
73	Redlands Rotary Club - Benjamin J. Rabe	This \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student who has shown outstanding citizenship and service to school and community and intends to pursue a career in architecture or engineering. The recipient must be a current or past member of the Boy Scouts of America for at least one year. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
74	Redlands Sunrise Rotary Club	This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a minimum 3.0 GPA or better, has been active in school and community, and has demonstrated outstanding citizenship. The recipient must plan to be enrolled in college.
75	Redlands Teachers Association	Several \$500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors who are committed to the profession of teaching. Recipients must be in good standing scholastically and have good citizenship. Qualified children with R.T.A. affiliations will be considered first.
76	Charles and Ruth Ronin Memorial	This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior with a 3.5 or higher GPA who will attend a four-year college or university on a full-time basis in pursuit of a bachelor's degree in political science, history, or education. Financial need is a consideration.
77	Soroptimist International of Redlands	This \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a senior who has participated in community service, will be attending an accredited college or university on a full-time basis, and plans on majoring in one of the following: health care, law, engineering, computer science, education and/or business administration.
78	Zonta Club-Young Women in Public Affairs (YWIPA) Award	Applicants must show an active commitment to volunteerism, experience in local and/or student government, and knowledge of Zonta International and its programs.

85	Wildcat Baseball Diamond Club: Rich Laabs Memorial, Coach Tony Memorial, Wildcat Scholarship	The Wildcat Baseball Diamond Club presents scholarships to Redlands East Valley High School seniors in good standing who participated in the REV varsity baseball program. The head coach, in cooperation with the Wildcat Baseball Diamond Club Board selects the deserving seniors for each award.
86	Darril Carlson Memorial	This scholarship is presented in memory of Darril Carlson, a local business owner who died unexpectedly in 2008. He was a person who had determination, love, and a Can Do attitude. He believed strongly in working hard and doing more with less. When he talked with people, he made them feel better about who they were. Darril's family would like to award a scholarship to a REV student (male or female) with a minimum 3.5 GPA who shares Darril's sense of determination and attitude. Applicants should attach a short essay entitled: Why I Should Receive This Scholarship. 87	Community Bank - Lee Guggisberg Foundation Memorial	Two \$300 scholarships will be awarded by the Lee Guggisberg Foundation. Qualifications for the scholarship are: recipient must complete the graduation requirements of the Redlands Unified School District, must be enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college or university prior to Community Bank releasing the scholarship money, and must plan to further his or her education in the field of business management or accounting.
