#	NAME	DESCRIPTION
1	Ruth Adams Memorial	This \$500 scholarship, awarded to a graduating senior girl who has been accepted and will be attending the University of Redlands in the fall as a full-time student, honors Ruth Adams, a science teacher at RHS from 1951 to 1957.
2	The AEI-CASC Engineering Scholarship	Three \$500 scholarships will be awarded to outstanding graduating seniors who intend to pursue a degree in Engineering at a four-year college or university. Students pursuing any Engineering degree are eligible, preference will be given to qualified students entering a program in Civil or Environmental Engineering. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, demonstrate an interest in an Engineering career and be involved in community service and/or extracurricular activities.
3	The Patty Ahearn-Victoria Elementary School	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior from any Redlands Unified high school who has a 2.5 GPA or higher. This student must have attended Victoria Elementary School for at least three years and has continued to follow the Victoria Peace Builder's Pledge.
4	Robinson G. Allen Athletic Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior whose athletic prowess has been limited for the most part to junior varsity teams. Sportsmanship, citizenship, scholarship and financial need are considered, and the recipient must attend an institution of higher learning on a full-time basis.
5	William A. Allen Memorial Metal Shop/Auto Body	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to an outstanding metal shop or auto body student who displays dedication, skill and a desire to become a true craftsman. The student should demonstrate creativity, show problem solving abilities, and exhibit good social skills.
6	American Business Women's Association	A \$500 or greater scholarship will be awarded to a graduating female senior seeking a business or professional career. Selection is based on scholastic standing and financial need.
7	Cindy Andrews Educational	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has been a CSF member for at least 4 semesters and who plans to be a teacher and eventually an administrator in the public school system.
8	Frank G. Araujo Memorial	Four scholarships of \$500 will be awarded to students of Mexican-American descent. The recipients must have a 3.0 or higher GPA, demonstrate good citizenship, and participate in school or community activities.

9	Connie "Chelo" Armendariz Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior planning to continue his/her education at a vocational school, junior college, or university. Preference shall be given to a student who attended the former Saint Mary's Catholic Church in Redlands. Applicants must indicate the years they attended this church. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: CONNIE ARMENDARIZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.
10	Timothy Baylink Good Fellowship Award	This \$1,000 award is presented to a graduating senior who submits an essay indicating how he or she meets the following criteria in their everyday life: (Good Friend) Must be someone who is willing to inconvenience him/herself for good friends and classmates, listens and gives good counsel, is unusually generous with his/her time and resources, is a person others are comfortable with because of his/her empathy and presence, and who has time for children. (Good Humor) Must be someone who has a sense of humor with intelligence, wit and understanding beyond his/her years and who makes people happy. (Free Spirit) Must be someone who is not always conventional, is a risk taker, someone who enjoys skiing, riding motorcycles, is interested in extreme sports and enjoys all types of music, and is eager for life's adventures. (Inspirational) Must be someone who brings out the best in people, who has a spiritual aura that will ensure he/she will never be forgotten, and whose explanations make you love knowledge. (Computer Geek) Must be someone who is fascinated by high tech gadgets. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: TIMOTHY BAYLINK GOOD FELLOWSHIP AWARD.
11	Beattie Middle School PTA	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who attended Beattie Middle School, has a 2.5 GPA or higher, and demonstrates good citizenship. Consideration will also be based on the student/family participation in PTA/PTSA membership and activities.
12	Beaver Medical Clinic Foundation - Dr. Glenn Adams Memorial Award	This \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is attending Redlands High School and is seeking a career in the field of medicine. The student must be outstanding academically, in leadership skills, and in sports participation, ensuring success in his or her planned career.
13	Beaver Medical Clinic Foundation - H.E.A.R.T. Academy Award	This \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is attending Redlands High School and is seeking a career in the field of medicine. The student must have participated in the HEART Academy program for three years.
14	Beaver Medical Clinic Foundation - Premedical Award	One \$4,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is seeking a career in the field of medicine. The student must be outstanding both academically and in leadership skills, ensuring success in his or her planned career.

15	The Garvin L. Beck Memorial	A \$1,000 scholarship and a \$500 scholarship will be awarded to students who have lettered in a junior varsity sport during the last two years of high school. Please attach a one-page essay using the following prompt: What I intend to do with the money, if selected, and my reason for attending college. At the end of the essay, the student should indicate which sport he or she has lettered in. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: GARVIN L. BECK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.
16	Raymond and Donald Beeler Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student with at least a 3.0 GPA. Financial need is a consideration. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who will attend a community or a four-year college on a full-time basis.
17	David Beltran Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a college-bound graduating senior, including local junior colleges, who plans to major in drama, theater arts or thespian studies.
18	Benchwarmers Club of Redlands - Jess Mercado Football	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a three-year member of the Redlands High School football team who has been a starter for at least one year, exhibited good citizenship, shown dedication, and has an eligible GPA.
19	Barbara Bonnema Memorial	Several \$500 or greater scholarships may be awarded to students who show academic excellence as well as a financial need. The students must also be college-bound graduating seniors who will be attending school on a full-time basis.
20	Boy Scouts of America Troop 3 Art Till/Nathan E. Smith Memorial	Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plan to attend an accredited college, university, or vocational program. Continued involvement in scouting and community service will be considered. Preference will be given to individuals who have attained the rank of Eagle Scout.
21	Quincy Brown Memorial	A scholarship of \$500 or greater will be awarded to a graduating senior who will enroll as a full-time student in a four-year college or university pursuing a business or teaching career. The student must have a 3.0 or higher GPA and have attended a Redlands Unified School District school for three consecutive years.
22	Bryn Mawr Elementary School PTA	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Bryn Mawr Elementary School for at least two years. The student must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA, have good citizenship, demonstrated community service, and have a desire to help others. The scholarship may be used at any college or trade school. Academic standing and financial need are also taken into consideration.
23	Kathy Bush Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has been outstanding in the field of instrumental music.

24	Nicholas C. Carter Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Redlands Senior High School male who has lettered in junior varsity or varsity soccer. Preference will be given to students who share Nicholas Carter's passion for soccer, culinary arts and/or military service. Applicants must present a 1 – 2 page informal essay demonstrating the impact that one of these interests has had on their life. The essay is intended to elucidate the student's passions rather than prove an aptitude in writing. Applicants should feel free to include humor, recount personal events, or find other unique ways to let their personality be revealed in their essay. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: NICHOLAS C. CARTER MEMORIAL
25	Cesar E. Chavez Memorial	This \$750 scholarship celebrates Cesar E. Chavez's legacy of compassion, education and equality for all Americans. It will awarded to a graduating senior who has shown exemplary leadership, given community service, and shows financial need. Please write a short essay explaining how you exemplify his spirit and how you intend to further honor it. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: CESAR E. CHAVEZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
26	Clement Middle School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended and was involved in school activities at Clement Middle School.
27	Contemporary Club	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who will continue to further his or her education in a career of his or her choice.
28	Cope Middle School PTSA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Cope Middle School for a minimum of two years. Citizenship and a desire to continue his/her education after high school are also a requirement. Priority will be given to a student whose parents were PTA volunteers.
29	Crafton Elementary School PTA	A \$500 scholarship will be given to a graduating senior from REV, RHS or CVHS who has a financial need and has demonstrated outstanding community service through his or her high school years. The student must have attended Crafton Elementary School.
30	Arthur H. Daniels Memorial	A scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating senior for citizenship, academic accomplishment, contribution to school and community, and future career plans. This scholarship will be granted to a college-bound student who plans to attend on a full-time basis.
31	Mike DeHoog Memorial	This \$500 scholarship is awarded in memory of Mike DeHoog, whose passions included architecture, photography, and woodworking. Preference will be given to a student with similar interests and plans to attend a vocational or technical school after graduation.

32	Pat Dermargosian Memorial	This \$300 scholarship will be given to a graduating senior whose parent has been actively involved in the PTA. Write a one page essay to the following prompt: Describe how your parent's involvement in the PTA has impacted your education. Please name the positions your parent has held. PLEASE NOTE APPLICATIONS WITHOUT DONOR SPECIFIC ESSAY TO ABOVE PROMPT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR SELECTION. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: PAT DERMARGOSIAN SCHOLARSHIP.
33	Roger Duffer "Genie" Award	A scholarship of \$500 will be presented to a choral member whose personal commitment, hard work, and musical integrity have perpetuated the high standards of the choral department as initiated by Mr. Roger Duffer.
34	James Mackenzie Fallows - Honoring Gertrude Baccus	This \$1,000 scholarship has been established in honor of Gertrude Baccus for a student who produces the best piece of expository writing. The donor does not have in mind a short story or poetry contest, but rather an essay, article, speech, or some other work of non-fiction designed to explore an idea or explain a situation with the clarity and logic that Mrs. Baccus insisted on from her students. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: JAMES MACKENZIE FALLOWS SCHOLARSHIP.
35	James Mackenzie Fallows - Honoring William Cunningham	This \$1,000 scholarship has been established in honor of William Cunningham for a student who shows great promise for public service in his/her career. Public service could include teaching, medical care, religious or volunteer work, or other expressions of the use of private talent for the public good.
36	Arthur and Juna Fisher Memorial Track	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has been active in track activities for at least two years and maintained a 3.0 or better GPA.
37	Franklin Elementary School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Franklin Elementary School and has extensive volunteer service in both school and community. Academic standing and financial need will be taken into consideration.
38	Gail Garner Memorial R.I.S.E.	A scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a student graduating through the Redlands Independent Study Education (R.I.S.E.) program from RHS, REV, CVHS, or OHS.
39	Bill Gibson Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a 3.0 GPA or higher and plans to attend a college, university, or vocational school on a full-time basis.

40	Gladiators Car Club Scholarship, in memory of Verne Kasper	One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior that has been accepted to a community college or trade school. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher in all subjects. Must have demonstrated an interest in the automotive industry. Leadership in school, community and church will be considered. Financial need is a consideration. Must submit an essay stating an interest in automotive industry and outlining where you want to be in five years. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: GLADIATORS CAR CLUB SCHOLARSHIP.
41	Ann and Brad Glassco	This \$500 scholarship is to be awarded to a student who has spent significant time during his/her high school years perfecting unusual skills that are outside of his/her high school interests. He/she must have been recognized for their accomplishments (i.e. Brandenberger Award at the Great Y Circus, state championship rider, Junior Olympic diver, professional performer.) The student must have a 2.5 GPA or better.
42	Jeff Godon Memorial Golf Scholarship	One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a member of the Boys Varsity Golf team who has demonstrated academic excellence, athletic achievement and has expressed a desire to play golf at a college level. He must have a GPA of 3.5 or better, will have lettered in Varsity Golf for at least two years at RHS. Candidate will have demonstrated good sportsmanship towards fellow teammates as well as opponents and coaches. Financial need is a factor.
43	Rachel Graham Memorial	Several scholarships at \$500 each will be awarded to graduating seniors who will attend a four-year college or university on a full-time basis. They must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA, shown good citizenship and participated in school and community activities.
44	Guzkowski Family	Two \$300 scholarships are awarded by the Guzkowski Family to recognize critical thinking in the area of government and public policy. The recipient must submit an essay that demonstrates an appreciation for and understanding of objective analysis and some of the problems and challenges confronting contemporary society, as well as the role that can be played by government through rational public policy in addressing these issues. Student applications will be evaluated based upon the following: The student must submit a 500-word essay, a portion of which must be an explanation of their thought process and methodology. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: GUZKOWSKI FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP.
45	Raymond L. Haight Memorial Scholarship	This \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior continuing his or her college learning in the field of education. Financial need is a consideration.
46	William T. Hartzell Memorial	This scholarship is given in memory of William T. Hartzell, community leader and lifetime resident of Redlands. This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has maintained at least a 3.5 GPA, shown leadership in school activities, plans to attend a four year college or university on a full time basis, and has attended Redlands area schools for three years or more.

47	R. Garn Haycock Memorial	This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a deserving senior who displays good citizenship, character, academic potential, has a need for financial assistance, and will attend an institution of higher learning on a full-time basis.
48	Eric L. Jacobson Memorial	This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has maintained a 3.0 or higher GPA, has participated on the speech or debate team for at least two years (one of which must be the senior year), and plans to attend a four-year college or university on a full-time basis. Additional consideration will be given to a student who demonstrates a variety of interests and performs service to school and community.
49	Brian Jimenez Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior male who has participated in baseball or soccer, has a GPA of 2.5 or higher, and will attend an institution of higher learning on a full-time basis. First preference is given to a student who plans to major in criminal justice or criminal law. The recipient should demonstrate a love of his family, be a strong but quiet role model, be respected by his peers, and be goal-oriented in his tasks.
50	Junior Women of the Contemporary Club	This \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated outstanding community service in countless areas during his/her high school years.
51	Annette and Ernest Keith Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is in the top ten percent (10%) of his or her class and will be attending a four-year California college or university on a full-time basis.
52	Alfred Kellum Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who is going to attend a two-year college or four-year university. The recipient is to have completed at least one year of ROTC in the RUSD program prior to graduation.
53	Gretchen Brown Kennard Memorial	One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Student must have attended Victoria Elementary school for at least 3 years and has continued to exemplify Victoria's Peace Builders Program
54	Kimberly Elementary School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Kimberly Elementary School for a minimum of three years, is an average or above-average achiever, demonstrates good citizenship, and preferably has not received other scholarships.
55	Kingsbury Elementary School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Kingsbury Elementary School for at least three years, has a minimum of a C average, and has demonstrated good citizenship and leadership. The student must show financial need. Involvement in extracurricular and community activities must be demonstrated.
56	Harold Leeming Memorial Scholarship, Honoring Myron J. Talbert	One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to graduating senior who have demonstrated an interest in engineering or physical science and has played an active part in school and community activities. Preference will be given to students who plan to study aerospace engineering or science.

57	Doreen Legg Memorial	This scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating senior who will enroll full-time at a four-year college or university pursuing a business or teaching career. The recipient must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and attended a RUSD High School for three consecutive years.
58	Jack A. and Louise S. Levine Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who plans to continue his or her education, has a 3.0 or higher GPA, demonstrates good citizenship, and has participated in school and/or community activities.
59	Lugonia Alumni/Harrison Lightfoot	Several \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who attended Lugonia Elementary School. The students must have extensive community service and/or be involved in school activities, demonstrate good citizenship, and have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. The scholarship may be used at any college, university, or vocational school.
60	Owen Locke Memorial	These scholarships are available to students with a 3.0 GPA or above and who demonstrate financial need. Please note you may not have applied for other Owen Locke scholarships offered by an organization other than the RCSF.
61	Macy Family Award for Persistent Effort	A \$500 scholarship may be awarded to recognize a student who has persistently put forth great effort to achieve academically. GPA or financial need is not a consideration for this award.
62	The Manazer Family Leadership Award	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who will attend a two-year or four-year college or university. The recipient must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and exhibit leadership qualities through extra-curricular activities, community service and work experience.
63	Mariposa Elementary School PTA	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Mariposa Elementary School for at least two years. The recipient must have demonstrated serious scholarship, good citizenship, and a desire for further education either in academics or a vocational trade.
64	McKinley Elementary School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended McKinley Elementary School for at least three years and plans to attend a college, university, or vocational school.
65	Dorothy Mitchell Memorial	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who plans to enter the teaching profession.
66	Moore Middle School PTA	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Moore Middle School for three years and plans to attend college or a trade school.
67	Harry Munoz Memorial	This \$1000 scholarship is presented in memory of Harry Munoz, a Redlands High School graduate of the class of 1940. Mr. Munoz lettered in four major sports and was a lifetime resident of Redlands and an active member of the community. This scholarship is given to a deserving graduate who has demonstrated academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and a desire to continue his/her education.

68	Rick Munoz Memorial	This \$500 scholarship is presented in memory of Rick Munoz. The recipient must have lettered in at least one sport in his or her senior year, as well as demonstrated high academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and a desire to continue his or her education.
69	Jack M. Nagasaka Memorial	A \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is outstanding in the field of math or science. The recipient will be selected based on grades and achievement test scores in chemistry, physics and or math.
70	Robyn Nance Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is active in dramatic arts, has utilized his or her talents to the utmost, displays a love and enthusiasm for the theater, and participates whenever and wherever needed.
71	Dominic Napoli Humantarian Award	This \$500 award will be presented to a graduating senior who has devoted extra time to helping others, has a high caliber of citizenship and wishes to further his or her education.
72	Doris Neblet Memorial	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior with a 3.0 or higher GPA who demonstrates exceptional ability in computer science. The student must also have good citizenship and plans to attend an institution of higher learning.
73	Mike Niemeyer Memorial Football	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is a member of the Redlands High School Terrier football team. The recipient must demonstrate academic achievement and good citizenship. Preference will be given to a high academic achiever. Preference will also be given to an offensive or defensive lineman. All players, starters or non-starters will be considered.
74	Northside Booster Club - Felix R. Sepulveda Memorial	The Northside Booster Club has established these \$500 scholarships to encourage athletes to maintain a good academic average. The scholarships will be awarded to a graduating male and female who have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA and participated in at least one sport.
75	Optimist Club of Redlands - Virginia Elliott	This \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior girl who has a minimum 3.0 GPA, a positive attitude, and involvement in service to the community.
76	Optimist Club of Redlands - Ralph Maloof	This \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior boy who has a minimum 3.0 GPA, a positive attitude, and involvement in service to the community.
77	PCH Architects LLP - Steven J. Lehnhof Memorial Architectural	A \$500 scholarship is presented in memory of Steven J. Lehnhof, an architecture and drafting teacher at Redlands High School for many years. It will be awarded to a graduating senior who will be majoring in architecture or architectural engineering at an accredited college or university.

78	James Halsey Pearce Memorial Scholarship	This \$300 scholarship is offered to a special education student continuing on to college. The recipient must have special needs in high school. A short statement explaining the special circumstances of the recipient must be attached. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: JAMES HALSEY PEARCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.
79	Marshall Phelps Athletic Memorial	This \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating male or female with proven athletic ability and interest in a career involving some phase of athletics, such as sports medicine, coaching, or physical therapy. Community service and leadership qualities are desirable but not essential. Student must plan to enroll in a two-year or four-year college program and have a minimum 2.0 GPA. Selection will be based upon high school counselors' recommendations.
80	The PoWeR To Continue Learning	This \$500 scholarship, offered by the Professional Women of Redlands, will be awarded to a graduating young woman who possesses a minimum 2.5 GPA, has participated in at least one school activity, and has demonstrated some type of community service. The recipient must be planning to attend a two-year or four-year college, or a vocational program. Preference will be given to a student who will be the first in her family to obtain a college degree or professional-level training. A short essay must be attached on the topic, Why I Want to Continue My Education. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: THE POWER TO CONTINUE LEARNING.
81	Redlands Administrative Personnel Association	Scholarships of \$500 or more will be awarded to the sons and daughters of members of RAPA. A screening committee composed of RAPA members will meet to determine the most deserving applicant, based on an objective scoring system.
82	Redlands Area Interfaith Council	This \$300 scholarship was created from the long history of promoting love and respect among all of the people of faith in our community. The student must provide a one-page essay using the following prompt: How I Can Be an Agent of Peace. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: REDLANDS AREA INTERFAITH COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP.
83	Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth	This \$350 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has participated in the Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth program, including scorekeepers or umpires, for a minimum of three years. The student must have exemplified good sportsmanship and academic achievement. Please include a 200 word essay entitled How Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth Has Impacted My Life. Indicate how many years and in what capacity you participated, i.e.: Player, Umpire, Scorekeeper. Applicants should include this information using one of the specific essays (RCSF web pages 28 through 34) and title it: REDLANDS BASEBALL - SOFTBALL FOR YOUTH.

84	Redlands Community Hospital Auxiliary	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who will attend a college or university and major in some type of allied-health program. The recipient must be a Redlands Community Hospital junior volunteer and must complete 100 hours of volunteer service by the end of the school year.
85	Redlands Council PTA - Dorathy Jolley Memorial	This \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a minimum 3.0 GPA and is active in a non-school service group such as church, scouts, or a community service club.
86	Redlands Community Scholarship Foundation - Honoring Ed Gleitsman	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior to assist in his or her pursuit of higher education in a business field.
87	Redlands Community Scholarship Foundation	A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior to assist in his or her pursuit of higher education.
